General Information:

RAMITOP 5MG TAB contains Ramipril, an **ACE inhibitor** used primarily to treat high blood pressure (hypertension), heart failure, and to reduce the risk of stroke and heart attack in high-risk individuals. By relaxing blood vessels, it helps reduce blood pressure, making it easier for the heart to pump blood. RAMITOP is also prescribed to protect the kidneys in patients with certain conditions like diabetes.

Indications and Uses:

- Treatment of high blood pressure (hypertension)
- Prevention of heart failure symptoms
- Improvement of survival after a heart attack
- Protection of kidney function in patients with diabetes and hypertension

Common Side Effects:
