Composition: Each tablet contains Telmisartan 40 mg, Amlodipine 5 mg, and Hydrochlorothiazide

12.5 mg.

General Information:

TELMICON-AMH TAB is a combination medication containing **Telmisartan**, an **angiotensin II receptor blocker (ARB)**, **Amlodipine**, a **calcium channel blocker (CCB)**, and **Hydrochlorothiazide**, a **thiazide diuretic**. This combination is primarily used to treat **hypertension (high blood pressure)** and to reduce the risk of cardiovascular events, such as heart attacks or strokes, by improving blood flow and lowering blood pressure. It may also be used to treat other heart-related conditions as prescribed by a healthcare provider.

Indications and Uses:

TELMICON-AMH TAB is used to manage high blood pressure in patients with or without other related conditions like **diabetes** or **chronic kidney disease**. It helps to reduce the risk of stroke, heart attack, and kidney problems by lowering blood pressure. The combination of three drugs ensures more effective control of blood pressure, especially in patients who may not respond well to single-drug therapy.

Common Side Effects:

- Dizziness
- Swelling in the legs or ankles
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Low blood pressure
- Increased urination

Less Common Side Effects:

- Abnormal heart rhythms
- Lightheadedness or fainting
- Nausea
- Rash
- Muscle cramps

Dosage and Administration:

The usual recommended dose of TELMICON-AMH TAB is one tablet taken once daily, or as prescribed by your doctor. It is generally recommended to take the tablet with or without food, ideally at the same time each day, to help you remember. The dose may be adjusted depending on your blood pressure and specific medical needs.

Warnings and Precautions:

- Pregnancy and Breastfeeding: TELMICON-AMH TAB is not recommended during pregnancy, especially during the second and third trimesters, as it may harm the fetus. It should also be avoided while breastfeeding.
- Kidney or Liver Disease: Use with caution in patients with kidney or liver problems.
- **Low Blood Pressure:** This medication can lower blood pressure, so it is important to monitor blood pressure regularly.
- **Electrolyte Imbalance:** Hydrochlorothiazide may cause changes in electrolyte levels, so regular blood tests are recommended.

Drug Interactions:

- **Potassium supplements**: May increase the risk of high potassium levels when used with Hydrochlorothiazide.

Contraindications:

- Allergy: Should not be used by individuals who are allergic to any of the components (Telmisartan, Amlodipine, Hydrochlorothiazide).
- **Pregnancy**: Should not be used during pregnancy.
- **Severe kidney or liver impairment**: Not recommended for patients with severe renal or hepatic impairment.
- Severe dehydration or electrolyte disturbances: Should be avoided.

Dos and Don'ts:

- Discuss any history of kidney, liver, or heart problems before starting the medication.
